Anna's summer won't be easy either; her dental work has started vigorously, following the waves of the pandemic. Summer holiday and the summer camps have started; her daughter, **Fanni**, can grow spiritually in a Christian camp.

We took leave of **Endre**; his wife, **Rózsika**, experiences God's consolation. For the time being, she is spending a few weeks at her son, Csaba, in Transylvania.

Csaba P. obtained his matura exam certificate with good marks. His place of work supports his professional further education, seeing his exceptional diligence in his studying and work.

The **R.** family is complete; the father (**Nori**, the husband) is released from prison. He has already found work and managed to find work at the same place for his son, too. They are planning their next step in life.

Laci Sz. with **Bea**, their four-year-old **Móni** and eleven-month-old **Fanni** lead a more and more harmonious life. Fanni can already walk alone, her steps are surer. Laci would like to find work in Dunakeszi.

Zoli J. has got a good opportunity in the building industry, but the illness of his boss had made his future uncertain there.

Our church and services

We are roughly 30 people coming together in the church, but the Zoom platform still helps many people.

Between 26 and 31 July, we can have our summer camp for people with an immunity certificate.

French relief, clothes and bread distribution

To our great pleasure, our French brothers surprised us with another relief in April. Before that, we had managed to distribute plenty of clothes in our new place, to the pleasure of many people.

Although we have been receiving people in need continually, giving them what is necessary from our storage, we have announced our huge clothes distribution for the beginning of July. We have also been able to render help to several people with the hospital equipments.

Bread distribution is done continually with few people, outside in the garden. We are grateful for a family growing vegetables whose donations help the poor and our foundation as well.

Construction

Gyula and István have done the necessary renovation of two bathrooms; we hope that there won't be any more leaks into the rooms under them. The ramp has also been made with handrails to help old and disabled people's movements.

The time has also come to discuss, talk over, pray over, and look over the



construction, the house extension, that is, the suggestions of our brother who is an architect, in person with the church members.

I think this year will be about the coordination and the completion of the plan so that next year the work can also start. We would like to pay attention to God's will very much. We desire unity from God as to the construction.

Prison Mission

Prison mission is slowly restarting. There are plenty of administration, coordination, and rules connected to it. Many of our missionary brothers and sisters served the Lord in other fields in the past almost one and a half years. It is difficult to find balance now, to go back to the prisons as well. There are some who don't even meet the obligatory requirements (e.g., immunity certificate).

Paul, our American missionary brother, will perhaps come in August.

As the Word of God encourages us, we ask our Lord to send out workers into His harvest.
